## **Coronavirus Procedures**

In order to reduce the gathering and take advantage of the large outdoor areas with a group of this size. Our goal is to remain outdoors for the duration of the event, and ask all players maintain social distance at all times.

#### Check In

All the Golf Carts will be staged in the field off the parking lot in front of the club house. We ask that golfers remain close to their designated golf carts until we make our way to the golf course with exceptions made to use the practice facility, golf shop, or restrooms.

#### Lunch & Dinner Service

A boxed lunch will be provided prior to the start of the event. Dinner will be served "to go" after the event. Golfers should make their way to the club house and pick up dinner in the staging area in a "drive thru" set up, and make their way to Highland 9 for the cash shoot out. Golfers are free to spread out around the green and shoot out tee box and take in the competition during dinner.

#### **Golf Carts**

Players will be asked to ride two to a cart unless signed up as a single. Cart dividers will be in place.

### **Tournament Format**

The Par 3 Tournament is a closest to the pin the competition. There will be a closest to the pin challenge on all 27 holes, and 3 "Ladies Only" for a maximum number of 30 shoot out qualifiers. Tournament players winning a closest to the pin challenge will qualify for the cash shoot out, which will take place immediately following the conclusion of play during dinner.

#### **Cash Shoot Out Rules**

1) A qualifying player will receive one shot in the shoot out. A tournament player may win multiple closest to the pin contests and prizes, but will NOT be granted multiple shots during the shoot out.

2) The shoot out order will be pre-determined by hole. A player who is not present when called to the tee box will forfeit their shot.

3) Prizes are as follows:

Closest to the Pin -	\$750
2 <sup>nd</sup> Closest -	\$400
3 <sup>rd</sup> Closest -	\$200
Hit the Green Pool -	\$1200

4) All players in the cash shoot out who hit the green will be given an equal portion of the "Hit the Green Pool".

5) Cash Prizes can be picked up in the golf shop starting Monday July 26<sup>th</sup>. Winner will be paid \$750 at the event wrap on Saturday July 24<sup>th</sup>.

#### Gross Competition (Optional)

There is an optional gross competition with prizes for the winners of each 9, and the overall Mens & Ladies 27 hole winner. All gross scoring will be done online through the Golf Genius mobile app. One player may enter scores for all players in the group. Each 9 hole course will have a different login Golf Genius Identification Code (GGID) containing 6 letters. The maximum score on any hole is 5.


